TECHNICAL NOTES

The wise Eagle told me that some carvers are not using their micromotors correctly. When removing large amounts of wood you should be using a Fordom, however several carver are using their micromotors and using large agresive bits at high speeds. This is not only hard on your hand piece but is not safe. Sabertooth and carbide bits should **not** be used at high speeds, if the handpiece **vibrates** the bit is bent or you are **going to fast!** Many of the handpieces can run at 45,000RPM or higher. These bits should be run at 24,000 RPM that's 50-60% of full speed.



FEATURE CARVER NIEL GRAY

Niel a long time carver with the AWCA has created a very unique piece of habitat a Canadian Tiger Swallow Tail Butterfly.





- > 1. Wings are made of plastic file folders.
- ➤ 2. Body is made of Brass tubing one smaller one for tail that fits into the larger tube for body. I used an old collet for my first butter fly because it had slits to insert the wings into. So now you have to cut slits into the tubing. I use body filler to shape the body.
- > 3. Dental floss with the fluffy ends I attach to the body for the legs
- ➤ 4. The tongue is made with dental floss and a drop of crazy glue on the end.
- > 5. Gesso and paint. I used a black sharpy to color the legs
- ➤ 6. You can make any butter fly you want, just look in the internet and apply the same techniques.

DOWNEY WOODPECKER



This class is designed for new and beginner carvers.

RYAN will walk the new carver through the various stages of carving from selecting the best wood to which tools to use including, micro motors, burners and painting as well as the various techniques for all the skills required for wildlife carving.

Some of these skills will be stoning and burning techniques as well as making legs, mounting and presentation of your project.

REQUIRED TOOLS: Students are required to bring a micro motor power grinder i.e. Strong, NSK, Foredom or similar machine. Some coarse bits and some fine bits. A burner i.e. Razertip, Colwood, burner tips i.e. large bent tip, straight tip. A pair of calipers, a flexible ruler or straight edge, a mechanical pencil, an assortment of paint brushes #1,2,3. Acrylic paint. Dust masks and safety glasses are recommended. Tool kits can be rented from the AWCA for 1st. year carvers not sure where to start. Kits are \$50.00 plus \$50.00 deposit. 
